*If you have a higher income than listed above, but have recently experienced a financial hardship, you may still qualify!

You Must Bring the Following Documents:

- Deed for the home in your name
- Current ID for all adults over 18 years
- Proof of income for everyone over 18 years (Ex: W2's, paystubs, SSI/SSD, food stamps)
- Proof of expenses (Ex: current utility bills, tax payment plan, medical bills, credit card, etc)
- Bank statement, 401k, insurance settlement, etc.
- Report cards for school age children
- Notarized letter of help from anyone who is helping you financially
- 2017 Federal & State tax return
